POCUS is a focused ultrasound examination which a clinician performs at the bed side. It allows for real - time, data - informed clinical decisions, without dependence on a specialist to obtain images or to interpret them.

In pediatric critical care, this ultrasound framework lends itself perfectly as it allows for procedures to be done safely and for rapid, convenient serial assessments aimed at improving diagnosis and monitoring.
